- d.To strive for cooperative growth as economic tool

BACKGROUND

Around the world modern cooperatives have developed for over 200 years. Cooperative institutions exist all over the world providing essential services, which would otherwise be unattainable. In many Third World countries, cooperatives such as credit unions and agricultural organizations have been very successful in helping people to provide for themselves where private and other corporate capitals do not see high profitability. In 90 countries of the world, over 700 million individuals are members of cooperative institutions. Globally, cooperatives have been able to elevate its position as a powerful economic model. In some countries, they are a sizeable force within the national economy. Presently, around 29 crore people in the India are directly linked with cooperative sector. There are more than 8 lakh cooperative societies, particularly, in agriculture, dairy and fisheries sectors provide rural population not just with livelihood opportunities but also with financial safety net with a community-based approach.

Cooperative Management

After Independence, cooperative institutions became an instrument of planning and state action. Not surprisingly, successful Indian cooperatives such as the Gujarat Cooperative Milk Marketing Federation Ltd (GCMMF)/Amul, Indian Farmers Fertiliser Cooperative Limited (IFFCO) and Krishak Bharati Cooperative Limited (KRIBHCO), are outside government control. Globally, seven of

the top 10 cooperatives by asset size are from the financial sector. The Indian financial sector is nowhere in the picture going by asset size. Cooperatives have also become avenues for regulatory arbitrage, circumventing lending and anti-money laundering regulations.

Need of Professional Management in Co-operative Ecosystem

The cooperative sector in India faces challenges on various fronts. There is a need for implementing the changes by building up and full filling the need of Professional Management in Cooperative Ecosystem. The course on Cooperative management is designed to create cadre of professionals who will be the changes agents in cooperative ecosystem.

DURATION

24 Weeks, comprising of 22 weeks classroom sessions by faculty of the Institute, field practitioners, industry professionals with hands-on experience, etc. and two weeks live projects by engaging participants with Cooperative, agribusiness ventures, various companies related to cooperative ecosystem.

COURSE FEE:

As decided by DGR, New Delhi. The participants have to pay separately for accommodation and Food.

The participants for the program should have at least a bachelor's degree.
