Cooperative Greetings to All !

The Primary Agriculture Cooperative Societies (PACS) have been provided by enabling ecosystem by Model Bye-Laws to diversify in to business activities including dairy, fishery, floriculture, setting up godowns, procurement, foodgrains, fertiliser, seed distribution, custom hiring centre, business correspondence activity by

adopting Model Bye-Laws. In alignment with the initiatives of Ministry of Cooperation for developing PACS as a Multi-Service & as Public Service Delivery Centre, the Institute has organised Awareness Programmes to outreach the members of PACS in states to sensitize on the initiatives of the Ministry of Cooperation and bring an understanding of the functioning as the Common Service Centre (CSC) and Multi-Service Centre. VAMNICOM has organised 70 training programmes and outreached participants of PACS in various states.

In context to formation of 3 National Bodies as Multi State- National Cooperative Export Ltd. (NCEL), National Cooperative Organic Ltd. (NCOL), Bharatiya Beej Sahakari Samiti Limited (BBSSL), the Institute has designed transformation programmes for the Apex Societies at National Level which aim to bring knowledge and understanding amongst the cooperative societies to realise export, potential through the Multi-State Cooperatives.

A training programme was organised on Seed Production and Marketing for the members of Cooperative Societies of KRIBHCO, (BBSSL). The Programme was instrumental on providing information of bye-laws of BBSSL, governance & marketing, seed production, marketing. VAMNICOM has scheduled transformation programmes to build eco-system for linkages with the cooperative societies with APEX, National Societies so that the producers can gain competitiveness to participate in value chain that provides higher income.

VAMNICOM's international outreach was enhanced by organising International Conference on Achieving SDGs: Global Cooperation for Transforming Agriculture towards the Food Secure Future. The conference was attended by delegates from 12 countries on secure food supply chain which can elevate people from poverty, provide employment and promote climate resilient agriculture. The Indian experience in governance and management of cooperatives was shared in the international programme which was organised by African-Asian Rural Development Organization (AARDO) and VAMNICOM. In the inaugural address of H.E. Dr. Manoj Nardeosingh, Secretary General, AARDO emphasised on collaboration and exchange of knowledge & consistent efforts to provide training for better policy and outcome.

During the visit of Mr. Korbinian März, Coordinator, Secretariat General of the International Raiffeisen Union, (IRU) and DGRV, his interaction with the students, faculty members and trainees provided perspective on cooperative development which needs to have member participation, good governance, management and audit system, his interaction with students provided a perspective on cooperative movement and emerging trends.

As the emerging opportunities needs to be capitalise by the PACS, they will need convergence and alignment of the members of cooperative societies with ongoing schemes encouraging youth entrepreneurship will be required.

All this require training, skilling and incubating business ideas, capacity building and empowering the cooperatives.

VAMNICOM is committed to building capacity and training the officials of cooperative departments and members of the cooperative societies and looks forward to receive proposals for organizing training programmes at our campus.

VAMNICOM PRESENTATION ON COOPERATIVES IN COMMITTEE ON AGRICULTRE, MSP & ORGANIC (12TH DECEMBER, 2023)



Director VAMNICOM was invited to the committee on Agriculture, MSP and Organic under the chairmanship of Shri Sanjay Agrawal, IAS at GUJCOMASOL, Gandhinagar. The management of production, marketing and other postharvest activity through PACS, FPO will play an important role in aggregation of the produce and to achieve the scale of the economy. The world's largest grain storage scheme through PACS, financial and market linkages will be required PACS and FPOs need to have better integration and partnership, to improve the competitiveness of agriculture export, market access and promote cooperatives and agricultural growth.

PROGRAMME ON "BANKING REGULATION (AMENDMENT) ACT 2020 AND CYBER SECURITY (12-14 DECEMBER, 2023)

WAREHOUSING DEVELOPMENT AND REGULATORY AUTHORITY (WDRA) PROGRAMMES FOR FARMERS / TRADERS & DAL MILL OWNERS

VAMNICOM conducted the following series of programmes sponsored by WDRA in association with Maharashtra State Warehouse Corporation (MSWC), Pune with main objective to impart knowledge on provisions for the development and regulation of warehouses, negotiability of warehouse receipts, major loan schemes of the bank to construct the warehouses.



WDRA programme was organized in association with CARE & MSWC, Pune at Velu Dist. under the coordinationship of Dr. Prashant V. Kadam, Programme Director on 14th December, 2023. 51 participants attended the programme. A study visit was also conducted at MSWC Godown at Market Yard, Pune where they were imparted with the knowledge to solve surfacing challenges during construction of the new warehouse.



2 one-day farmer awareness programmes were conducted by Dr. Mahesh Kadam, Programme Director on 14th December, 2023 in association with MSWC and FarmEducon Research Foundation at Gokhali, Indapur, Pune with 56 participants from Gokhali Vividh Karykari Seva Sahakari Sanstha, Gokhali, Tal. Indapur, Pune and on 18th December, 2023 at Dharmabad, Nanded in association with MSWC, FarmEducon Research Foundation and Bothi Agro Producer Company with 54 participants.



Shri. Shivaji Walke, Research Officer coordinated the programme on 14th December, 2023 and the programme on 18th December, 2023 was jointly coordinated by Shri. Shivaji Walke, Research Officer and Dr. Jagadish Aditya D. Research Officer.
