## Study Visit Report (Day 1Hyderabad)

A group of PGDM-ABM (Post Graduate Diploma in Management - Agri-Business Management) students from VAMNICOM visited the Incubating Center at the Indian Institute of Millet Research in Rajenderanagar, Hyderabad, on January 1, 2024, as part of their academic program.
