Sambhajinagar Districts participated in this programme.

The participants were exposed to a wide range of topics covering MSWC & Warehouse Registration and Rules in collaboration with the Warehouse Development and Regulatory Authority (WDRA), the WDRA registration process, the construction of warehouses including site selection, the e-NWR issuing process, the handling of Transferable and Non-transferable receipts, the procurement process for godown construction, Agri Value Chain and Supply Chain Management, Financial Management tailored for Farmer Producer Organizations, Social and Environmental Action planning, sustainability and environmental considerations in warehouse business, effective record-keeping practices for warehouse operations, implementing scientific storage systems, conducting store grain sampling processes, and strategies for marketing and branding specifically aimed at Farmer Producer Organizations.

Record keeping for Warehouse business, Scientific Storage system, Store grain Sampling process, Marketing and Branding for Farmer Producer Organization etc.

Further the bank has to undertake special recovery drive during last quarter of financial year during January-March & therefore the knowledge on legal provisions under various Sections is a must & also knowledge on practical approach to be adopted by the Recovery Officer & therefore organization of exclusive focused training programme on recovery management with practical inputs plays an important role in achieving timely recovery of the loan disbursed to the customers & to be within the upper limit for NPA percentage i.e gross NPA below 5%.

WOMEN'S DAY CELEBRATION (08 MARCH, 2024)


