VAMNICOM, a National Institute under the aegis of National Council for Cooperative Training (NCCT), promoted by Ministry of Cooperation, Govt. of India, is responsible for organizing, directing, monitoring and evaluating the arrangements for cooperative training of the personnel working in the cooperative sector in the country. Established way back in the year 1946 in Mumbai as a Cooperative Training College, VAMNICOM shifted to Pune in 1967 and has now become an intellectual and vibrant nerve centre of cooperative education, training and research. VAMNICOM has established itself as the apex center for Cooperative Management Training, Research and Consultancy not only in India, but it has also extended its activities to other countries in South East Asia in the sphere of Cooperative Training and Education. VAMNICOM is a part of national network of cooperative institution comprising of 5 Regional Institutes of Cooperative Managements (RICMs) & 14 Institutes of Cooperative Management (ICMs) spread over the entire country. The main objectives of VAMNICOM are to organize need based training programmes and facilitate the process of Human Resource Development of cooperatives for the country. It also envisages conducting research in critical areas of cooperative movement.
